Christ in Isaiah	The book of Isaiah prophecies the first and second coming of Christ. (Child born of a virgin-7:14, the suffering servant-53:5, Reign of peace-9:6)			

Christ-Centered Reading...

This refers to the centrality of Christ and God's redemptive plan in all scripture and biblical revelation. It establishes the unity of scripture and affirms the centrality of Christ in all things including our lives as believers

- Immanuel 7:14
- Messianic titles 9:6
- Root of Jesse 11:10
- Branch of the Lord 4:2

- Servant of the Lord 42:1
- Light of the nations 49:6
- Man of sorrows 53:3
- Righteous servant 53:11

And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he interpreted to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning himself... Luke 24:27

Biblical Theology...

Refers to the pursuit of understanding and articulating the revelation of God as presented by the Bible within the biblical texts and contexts.

- Biblical theology presents a progressive revelation of God from Genesis to revelation through the historical and literary context of Scripture which is culminated in the perfect revelation of Christ as God's radiance and representation. (Hebrews1:3)
- Beyond the place of enriching the honorable art of teaching and preaching, biblical theology provides believers with the opportunity to know God by His nature and character as shown in His word for a better understanding of His purpose for all His creation including us.

Theology in the book of Isaiah...

- The Holy God our redeemer For I am the LORD your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. I give Egypt as your ransom, Cush and Seba in exchange for you. 43:3
- The God who is present and protects fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. 41:10
- The God of comfort and restoration Comfort, comfort my people, says your God. Speak tenderly to Jerusalem, and cry to her that her warfare is ended, that her iniquity is pardoned, that she has received from the Lord's hand double for all her sins. 40:1-2

Theology in the book of Isaiah...

- The God of His word "For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven and do not return there but water the earth, making it bring forth and sprout, giving seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it. 55:10-11
